University Regulation 05.10.070

B. # course use service and administrative fees are established if the respective chancellor or designee determines that such fees are reasonable and appropriate. The chancellor will establish a process for a review and continuing or periodic review of student fees. The chancellor will establish a process for assessment of the fee amount of the estimated annual revenue and the proposed use of receipts from the fee and the proposed effective date of any new or revised fee. The process for continuing reviews shall provide for student comment and input including notice to students of course related fees and their use at the beginning of each semester and inclusion of a request for the level of satisfaction that is evaluated. Fees are part of the student's teaching or course evaluation.

#. # course fees shall be a fair and equitable distribution of the total cost of providing the course such as the cost of the materials that are used. It is not economically convenient to purchase materials in quantities required for individual use or for the use of several instructors in a laboratory and other equipment.

@. ° All student fees including student government fees, course fees, use and service fees, and administrative fees shall be published in the course schedules, student and course and registration instructions - all U°Us shall maintain a website that identifies all student fees and discloses for each the amount of the fee, its purpose, the basis for the fee, and an explanation of the use of the proceeds. The university shall maintain an information disclosure of the various fees that are charged to students. # courses listed in each academic catalog that traditionally or normally have an associated course or other fees shall be listed as a fee designator that will direct the reader to the website that contains the date fee information.

K. 7 fees must be established far enough in advance to be included in the semester course schedule. Voluntary fee increases shall be charged to students for reasons that are beyond the control of the student receiving the increase. The fee or fee increase is not automatically effective if the chancellor or the chancellor's designee is not authorized to delegate the responsibility to the chancellor.
