The changes proposed for the Bachelor of Science in Fisheries Science will have little to no impact on budget, facilities/space, faculty, etc., in SFOS. FISH 411 could see a slight decline in enrollment if students opt for GEOG 312, SOC 440, and MSL elective courses, and those courses could see a slight increase in enrollment (2-4 students per year maximum). For other departments, we have recommended (in most cases) alternative courses that are also within the same program. As a result, we would not anticipate a net difference in student
