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C. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF DESIGN

After the design has been completed, it is reviewed and approved by the customer. This step involves a detailed examination of the design to ensure it meets all specified requirements and is feasible for implementation.

The review process typically includes:

• A formal presentation of the design to the customer's team.

• A discussion of the design's strengths and weaknesses.

• An analysis of the design's performance against the specified requirements.

• A review of the design's cost and feasibility.

• A final decision on whether the design is approved or requires further modification.

If the design is approved, it is documented and passed on to the next stage of development.

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
