


The resource requirements listed above reflect those required for the proposed M.M. degree as it will replace the current M.A. degree. The need for additional required resources would increase


substantially should the Department of Music attempt to retain the M.A. degree concentrations in Music Composition, Conducting, Music History or Music Theory in accordance with standards established by our accrediting agency, the National Association of Schools of Music (NASM). The most significant additional need would involve creating new faculty positions needed for teaching the graduate curriculum in each of these concentrations.
