- 1) Election of the Faculty Senate

- 2) The Dean/Director's Office should consult the Faculty Senate on all matters of faculty governance.
- 3) The Dean/Director's Office should consult the Faculty Senate on all matters of faculty governance.
- 4) **NON-ACADEMIC**
Dean/Director's Office should consult the Faculty Senate on all matters of faculty governance.
 - Tenure-track, research, and other full-time faculty are represented on the Faculty Senate, and may participate in the election of the Faculty Senate.
 - Part-time faculty are not represented on the Faculty Senate and should not participate in the election of the Faculty Senate.
 - In accordance with the Faculty Senate's Bylaws (GIL 1.1), the Faculty Senate represents the full-time research, instructional, and administrative faculty.
 - Faculty with administrative responsibilities are not represented on the Faculty Senate.
- 5) Election of the Dean/Director's Office should consult the Faculty Senate on all matters of faculty governance.
