MOTION:

The UAF Faculty Senate moves to establish a process for the selection of the two (2) Graduate Student members of the Graduate Academic and Advisory Committee.

Effective: Immediately

Rationale: According to the Faculty Senate bylaws, "The Graduate Academic & Advisory Committee includes ten faculty members and up to two graduate students. The Dean of the Graduate School, Director of the Library, and the University Registrar are non-voting ex officio members. The purpose of this document is to establish an inclusive process by which graduate students select their representative(s), whose names are then sent to the Dean of the Graduate School for appointment to the GAAC.
